## OVERCOMING ADVERSITY

The Gator Junior Golf Association's mission is to enhance the lives of youth by promoting team-building via in-class games, establishing mentorship through our Play Days, and building character with our life skills curriculum--through the game of golf. Our Fall 2020 season included 14 weekly classes, 192 children, 4 golf courses, 25 volunteers and 20 staff coaches. Despite the pandemic, we're giving our kids a reason to smile in more ways than ever.


### COVID-19

Like many other programs, we temporarily suspended our golf classes due to COVID-19. However, we saw our strongest demand ever in Fall 2020. We implemented strict safety standards to keep our kids and coaches safe. We had one of our highest season-to-season retention ratios ever at 62% returning from spring to fall. In 2020, we delivered a total of 360 instruction hours to children from all backgrounds.

### Expansion to Marion County

We've joined Juliette Falls Golf Course to deliver a new golf program in Marion County for Spring 2021. We're also growing to include an exclusive Girls Program to Candler Hills Golf Course in Ocala, Fla as well as continuing our PGA Junior League program, where students can have fun learning in a competitive environment. The Gator Junior Golf Association has expanded exponentially in 5 years, thanks to our committed coaches and supporting families. We can't wait to tackle the next 5 years as we continue to impact the lives of youth through golf and Grow The Game.





2020 was a challenging year for the Gator Junior Golf Association. Thanks to our dedicated coaches and supporting golf courses, we expanded our ever-growing footprint in north central Florida. In Fall 2020, we reached 192 children through our weekly and scholarship programs. Our kids have countless opportunities to set them up for future success. Most importantly, we've grown responsibly by recruiting more volunteers and hiring more qualified staff coaches, including PGA Professionals. In our Fall 2020 season, we retained 62% of students- one of the best ever.


In 2020, COVID-19 couldn't slow us down. Our impact to Grow The Game is clear, and we're excited to make 2021 our best year yet!






### Student Diversity
