




GATOR JUNIOR GOLF 2021 IMPACT REPORT

CHANGING THE GAME

The Gator Junior Golf Association's mission is to enhance the lives of youth by promoting team-building via in-class games, establishing mentorship through our Play Days, and building character with our life skills curriculum--through the game of golf. By the end of 2021, we added 3 golf classes to our very full schedule. Our Fall 2021 season included a total of 17 weekly classes, 220 children, 5 golf courses, 25 staff coaches and countless volunteers. Even in a pandemic, we've found creative ways to reach more young lives through golf.

Online Instruction

One of the unique aspects of our junior golf program is our website's eLearning content. Parents and students are encouraged to continue the learning process at home using our eLearning portal where students have instructional videos and online quizzes and homework available to them. It's a great way to learn golf at home during a pandemic. As we grow our curriculum, we continue to build out instructional content because we want to keep our kids stimulated during all days of the week- starting with the one hour per week at class.


Expansion to Lake City

2021 was a great year for the Gator Junior Golf Association. We added to our most advanced Level 5 classes, giving our kids more opportunities for continued growth on the golf course. We now have a total of 7 levels of instruction that allow kids to start with us at age 4 and move up as they grow and mature. 100% of our students move up from one level to the next each year. We continue to add highly qualified instructors to lead our programs, including PGA Professionals.

We also launched an initiative, Golfing Gators Apparel, in an effort to raise enough funds one day to provide golf clothes to our scholarship students. Our continued focus is on making the game of golf accessible to all. We strive to enable our families to overcome the barriers to entry to golf as we guide more youth on a path toward a successful future.
